

CRITERIA FOR SCORING STUDENT PRODUCTION

Master's Program in Ecology – PPG-EcoMar

Postgraduate Program in Coastal and Marine Ecosystem Sustainability

I. The student must earn at least 11 (eleven) credits in scientific activities during their enrollment period. Among these, at least 1 (one) publication in a journal with a minimum Qualis classification of B3, with the student as the first author, is required.

1 – Original Articles:

Articles in journals with the new Qualis A1 and A2 – 04 credits

Articles in journals with the new Qualis A3 and A4 – 03 credits

Articles in journals with the new Qualis B1, B2, and B3 – 02 credits

Articles in journals with the new Qualis B4 and B5 – 01 credit

Unisanta Bioscience as the first author – 1 credit

Full paper as the first author at an international event – 2 credits

Full paper as the first author at ENPG Unisanta – 2 credits

Full paper as the first author in conference proceedings – 1 credit

Abstract in conference proceedings – no credit

2 – Books or Book Chapters:

Publication of a book as author or co-author with an international publisher – 3 credits

Publication of a chapter as author or co-author with an international publisher – 2 credits

Book or chapter with a national publisher – 1 credit

3 – Participation in mini-courses and/or lectures at ENPG related to Ecology – 0.5 credit per mini-course/lecture
