

Criteria for scoring student production

Academic Master's Degree

I. Before the defense, the student must submit a scientific article related to the thesis topic to a journal with a Qualis rating of B1 or higher.

II. During the program, the student must earn at least 6 (six) credits in scientific activities.

III. Scoring Criteria:

1. Original Articles:

- Articles in journals with the new Qualis ratings A1 and A2 – 4 credits
- Articles in journals with the new Qualis ratings A3 and A4 – 3 credits
- Articles in journals with the new Qualis ratings B1, B2, and B3 – 2 credits
- Articles in journals with the new Qualis ratings B4 and B5 – 1 credit
- Full paper as the first author in an international event – 2 credits
- Full paper as the first author in the ENPG Unisanta event – 1 credit (maximum of 4 credits throughout the course)
- Full paper as the first author in conference proceedings – 2 credits
- Abstract in conference proceedings as the first author – 1 credit per abstract (maximum of 3 credits throughout the course)

2. Books or Book Chapters:

- Publication of a book as author or co-author with an international publisher – 3 credits
- Publication of a book chapter as author or co-author with an international publisher – 2 credits
- Book or chapter with a national publisher – 1 credit

3. Participation in Short Courses at ENPG or other events related to Environmental Sciences – 1 credit per short course (maximum of 3 credits throughout the course).
